**XVI Inter-American CM Encounter
Vilches, Talca of diocese - Chile**



On the 12 to 15 October, held in Vilches, diocese of Talca, Chile, the XVI inter-American MC Encounter, that met all of the 18 countries of Latin America in which take place Cursillos.

In an environment of great enthusiasm and hope the works had great success and were adopted the following conclusions:

By the mercy of God, we celebrate the XVI inter-American Encounter of GLCC, in the retreat house of St. Alberto Hurtado, Vilches, of the Diocese of St. Augustine in Talca, Chile, from 12 to 15 October 2017, where we gather with the eighteen (18) countries members of the Latin American Group of Cursillos (GLCC): Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Dominican Republic, Uruguay and Venezuela; summoned from the unity, communion and fraternity of the CM in the Latin America and Caribbean; in an environment in which prevailed the hope, prayer and joy, with the objective of reviewing the CM in the light of the Fundamental Ideas of the movement of Cursillos in its third edition (FICM3) and elect the head offices of the OMCC and GLCC for the period 2018-2021.

Participated some special guests and Francisco Salvador, in his condition of President of the OMCC.

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In the Encounter were presented four conferences. To analyse these conferences, ten groups were formed. Its conclusions were collected as follows:

1 THE FAR WAY AND THE CM

- The person is the center of the CM
- The CM is a way to meet with the Lord, is a means to integrate the person with Jesus Christ through an ad kerygmatic announce, giving him back the joy in Christ, making him participate of the Grace
- The human realization is an essential part of Christian life
- The "far way" are people who:
 - 1) Lost their reference to Jesus Christ and thus are away of His presence;
 - 2) Live irregular situations in the active life of the Church;
 - 3) Living in irregular situations but not feel excluded from the life of the Church and the sacramental participation.
- "*The Precursillo in principle does not exclude anyone: anyone can be susceptible to evangelization in the CM*" FICM3ed - 178. However, "*with prudence and charity*" we must pay special attention to the people that the Cursillo will not benefit or bring solutions to their lives.



2 THE CM A CRISTOCENTRICA AND PAULINA SPIRITUALITY

- There is a need to determine and specify the characteristics of the spirituality of the CM
- The CM's spirituality is centered on the person of Christ, which is based and updates on the liturgical life, which is the celebration of the mysteries of Christ, in a conscious way, growing and communicated
- The experience of spirituality of the CM begins at the triple encounter in the Cursillo
- The spirituality of the CM is "*the blood of the cursillista*", way of Holiness and ecclesial community, which deepens in the course of the tripod in compliance with its last purpose, which is the Gospel fermentation of environments.

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- Evangelization in the CM should be permanent, following the example of St. Paul: "Woe to me if I don't preach the Gospel" (1Cor 9.16)

3. FICM3ed, SUPORT FOR THE UNIT, THE COMMUNION OF THE CM IN THE XXI CENTURY

- The communion is a gift from God
- Communion in the CM lies of our charism, our mentality and being an ecclesial Movement with a purpose, a strategy and a method
- We must give witness of unity and communion, in order to ferment of the Gospel, starting with live and share communion in our schools of leaders and, from that reality, makes them present in Christian groups (group meetings), in Ultreyas, in the Secretariats, International Groups and the OMCC
- Today's leaders have a great responsibility: to be the builders of communion in CM
- It is necessary to develop a spirituality of communion, imitating the Holy Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - being in communion with the Church
- The communion facilitates the possibility to live the spirit of the CM "*I am because we are*"
- FICM3ed is our mark of communion, which attached to the status of the World Body and should be applied with Determination, Discernment, Diversity and Dialogue



4. THE POPE'S MESSAGE AND THE CM

- The Pope invites us to go out to meet the brothers and sisters, looking for new strategies of evangelizing message delivery
- The Pope invites us to action, and so we need to update strategies for tackling the problems of the 21st century, with creative fidelity
- There is manifested urgency for the training of leaders through the FICM3ed and the documents of the Church in schools of leaders
- The CM as an Ecclesial Movement listen the Church through which proposes the Pope through the documents of the Magisterium, the Episcopal Conferences and Diocesan bishops
- Being a Church movement, the CM should take its missionary dimension, and this can only be carried out with the participation and commitment of the leadership

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- Contrasting the ideal with the real in all aspects of the movement, we realized that it is necessary to walk in the light of the FICM3ed and of the documents of the Church, so that the CM will continue to respond to the signs of the times, looking for the structures of the movement have life

ELECTION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE OMCC AND GLCC FOR THE PERIOD 2018-2021

According to the establishing in the status of the World Body of Cursillos (OMCC) in chapter II Article 4 and the Organic Statute of the Latin American Group of Cursillos (GLCC) in article IV, proceeded to the election of the new headquarters of the Executive Committee of the OMCC and GLCC's Executive Committee, for the period 2018-2021.

Appointed an Election Commission for both elections, composed of: father Carlos Ramírez (Guatemala), Alberto Stang (Argentina), Dolores de Hajar (Peru) and Miriam of Aguilera (Honduras). The Assembly, composed of eighteen (18) countries, determined that the votes to be through secret ballot and by a simple majority.

- For service of the Executive Committee of the OMCC proposed the National Secretariats of: El Salvador and Mexico. The vote was held with the following results: Mexico: Fifteen (15) votes and El Salvador: Three (3) votes
- For service of the Executive Committee of GLCC proposed the National Secretariat of Chile. The vote was getting the following result: Chile: eighteen (18) votes

Complied with these acts, the President of the Executive Committee of GLCC congratulated Mexico and Chile for their elections, expressing them from the spirit of unity and communion of the MCC, let be guided by the Holy Spirit to the watch continuously in their new tasks, fit for the evangelization of the peoples of Latin America, and Caribbean and the world, and thanks to the delegation of El Salvador by your availability.

Then invited the Assembly to congratulate them with their cheers and later, the new elected representatives for each Committee, in the voice of each of its Presidents, expressed his thanks for the confidence placed in them before so important task in the Universal Church.
